Greetings to All!

The staff of DCVC Processing Services Department works tirelessly to make sure that your claims are paid in a timely manner. We need your help to make this process work better for everyone!

- A large number of sexual assault protocols forms submitted to our office are missing required information, including:
 - a. The remittance address is missing or incorrect
 - b. The SANE signature is missing
 - c. The Victim's signature is missing
 - d. The location of the crime or date of crime is missing
 - e. A page of the Protocol is missing (both pages of the Sexual Assault Protocol are required)
 - f. Incorrect forms are submitted. For example DCVC sometimes receives UB04's (these do not replace the Sexual Assault Protocol)
- All pertinent information is required on the Sexual Assault Protocol and cannot be omitted when requesting reimbursement from DCVC. We must deny or reject a claim, if it is submitted incorrectly thus delaying reimbursement.
- Please remember you have 180 days from the date of service to submit a claim.
- ***NO VICTIM IN SOUTH CAROLINA SHOULD EVER BE BILLED FOR A RAPE EXAM, NOR SHOULD THEIR HEALTH INSURANCE. ALSO, NEVER SEND A RAPE VICTIM'S ACCOUNT TO COLLECTIONS. Please call or email R.Brockman@scag.gov for questions or concerns, regarding any billing issues.***
